Issues Discussed:

1. Treasurer's Report:

2. Deeds- Ken and Jose will drive around the neighborhood and check deed violations.
3. Civic center needs to someone to do repairs and paint. Total costs are about \$2500 for upgrades.
Donna made the motion. Emmeline seconded the motion. The motion passed.
4. Donna talked about a walking track, barbeque pit, tether ball, volleyball net
5. There was a discussion on what kind of barbeque pit and where it will be located.
6. Sound system is approximately \$200. Donna made a motion for the sound system, Emmeline seconded the motion. The motion passed.

8. The baby pump was fixed at a cost of \$400, the civic center was flooded. Spouts should be fixed.
9. Vending Machines-There was a discussion about whether money should be made. Company will charge 75 cents. Chris asked that if vending machines could charge \$1 to help pay for the electricity.
10. Trees needs to be maintained. \$6,000 was paid because they were not maintained properly. Jose proposed that they should be maintained properly.
